EXAMINATION PROGRAMME – 2023

1.0 VALUATION AND ESTATE SURVEYING DIVISION

1.1 PROFESSIONAL TRAINEES PARTS(I) AND (II)

All professional trainees desirous of taking their examinations this year are to take note of the following requirements.

- Submit a synopsis on a project topic relating to your schedule of duty/work. This must be approved by your trainer.
- Prepare and Submit Three (3) Reports Capital Valuation, Rental Valuation; and a Technical Report/ Essays on the approved topic.
- Take Written and Oral Examinations.

1.2 ELIGIBILITY FOR TAKING THE EXAMINATIONS

Part I: Trainees should have had at least one (1) year post -registration experience/training in an approved office. In other words, the candidate should have been admitted as a Professional Trainee on or before **31**st **October 2022**.

Part II: All Trainees who have passed the first-year examinations or are exempted from the first-year examination.

1.3 APPLICATION TO BECOME TECHNICIAN SURVEYORS

Applicants are to submit Two (2) Valuation Reports (Capital and Rental) after at least two (2) years of postregistration experience in an approved office.

1.4 MEMBER TECHNICIANS PROGRESSING TO PROFESSIONAL MEMBER CLASS

Open to Member Technicians who wish to progress to professional status. The applicant must have served a minimum of six (6) years as a Technician. The applicant then goes through Parts (1) & (II) requirements as indicated above (1.2).

1.5 MATURE CANDIDATES

Candidates must hold a university degree in a core program accepted by the VES Division. Must be at least forty-five (45) years of age with a proven track record of VES Practice and experience for an aggregate period of fifteen (15) years in an approved office. Candidates are to submit three (3) Reports, two (2) of which must be on Valuation (Capital and Rental), and One (1) **Essay on any relevant topic relating to the applicants' schedule of duty** and attend an interview.

1.6 DATES APPLICABLE TO THE ABOVE EXAMINATIONS

2.5 SURVEYING TECHNICIANS PROGRESSING TO PROFESSIONAL MEMBER CLASS

Open to Surveying Technicians who wish to progress to professional status. The applicant must have served a minimum of five (5) years in the Surveying Technicians Class.

2.6 MATURE CANDIDATES EXAMINATIONS

Open to University Graduates of not less than forty-five years of age with proven track record of QS practice and experience for an aggregate period of fifteen (15) years.

3.0 LAND SURVEYING DIVISION

Open to professional Trainees who have served their first-year term of traineeship or more.

3.4 SURVEYING TECHNICIANS PROGRESSING TO PROFESSIONAL MEMBER CLASS

Open to Surveying Technicians who wish to progress to the Professional class status. The applicant must have served a minimum of four (4) years in the Surveying Technician Class.

3.5 MATURE CANDIDATES ENTRY EXAMINATION FOR PROFESSIONAL OR TECHNICIAN CLASS

The Candidate:

- Must attain a minimum of forty-five (45) years (i)
- Must have worked for an aggregate period of fifteen (15) years in a recognized office as a "Surveyor." (ii)
- Must have obtained a recognized University Degree (for Professional Class) or a Higher National Diploma (iii) (for Technician Class) in Surveying and Mapping Sciences.
- Must have gone through the necessary procedures and had the approval from the Governing Council of (iv) GhIS as a mature candidate.

Further information on submission of practical task, mode of examination and fees to be paid will be communicated to trainees after registration.

4.0 **ELEVATION TO FELLOW (ALL DIVISIONS)**

Applicant must have been a Professional Member for at least Ten (10) years and gualify as per the Marking Scheme.

Note: Deadline for submission of Application is October 15, in each year. No application will be considered after that date.

- a. Please do not attempt to either register or take the examinations if you have not met the gualification criteria.
- b. You must therefore produce your approval letter at both the Refresher Course and Examination Centres without which you will not participate in either of them.
